


Humanitarian Response



Supporting communities in crisis as they recover and rebuild



In July 2022, a 7.0-magnitude earthquake struck the mountainous province of Abra in the Philippines, causing flash flooding and destruction of homes and infrastructure. In 2023, Alongside Hope provided funds and support to restore clean water to the community.

In many cases, emergency response donation are leveraged through government matching funds. We are also in contact with any partners working in the region to offer prayers and ask what support they might need. These partnerships help us maximize our impact and your donations to make a world of difference in the lives of people affected. This support can include food, shelter and medical attention, as well as mental health support. Later, funds can be used to rebuild infrastructure, provide training for income earning and farming support to grow food.
