When political violence forced Asqual Hagos, 35, to leave her home in Tigray, Ethiopia, she ended up in a settlement for Internally Displaced People with her kids in tow, and her husband in Sudan. “Thanks to [Alongside Hope] and Lutheran World Federation, I am no longer idle. This business - the one I dared to dream - has become my reality. Stress and anxiety have given way to purpose and determination.”



“This assistance has provided me some relief and allowed me to put food on the table for my children. I bought essential food items such as wheat flour, rice, sugar, tea, milk and vegetables. We do not know how we are going to make ends meet with no source of livelihood. ... A small packet of rice costs in hundreds these days. We need opportunities to revive our livelihoods.”
